Tournament Conditions

The Open and Intermediate Divisions are American Backgammon Tour (ABT) events. The Tournament reserves the right to refuse an entrant without giving any reason. USBGF membership is required for participants in the Open and Intermediate divisions. Membership can be obtained at **usbgf.org** or at the tournament.

USBGF rules will be observed, with options in place. Clocks are required in all events except the Novice Division, Cancelgammon, and Quickies. In these events, clocks will only be used if both players agree. The directors reserve the right to impose a clock on any match that is delaying the tournament. Information on rules options and clock settings for each event will be available at https://wisconsinbackgammon.weebly.com/rules.html. The Tournament reserves the right to disallow an entrant from playing below their skill level.

All players must check in by Saturday, August 10 at 10:00 am, or notify us of later arrival; otherwise, they will be considered a NO-SHOW. Only cash will be accepted on site. All deposits are fully refundable until August 10 at 10:00 am.

Entry Fee Structure

All entry fees and pools in the Open, Intermediate, and Novice Divisions are 100% return. In addition to the standard entry fee, there are two separate prize pools in the Open and Intermediate Divisions. - All players in all divisions must pay the Entry Fee (\$180 Open/\$90 Intermediate/\$30 Novice).
- Players may also enter the optional Equity Pool (\$180 Open/\$90 Intermediate). This will pay the same places as the entry fee, but only to those who entered the Equity Pool.
- The optional Side Pool (\$180 Open/\$90 Intermediate) can only be entered by players in the Equity Pool. It will pay one or two places, depending on the number of players in the pool.

Players in the Open and Intermediate Divisions must pay a \$50 registration fee (includes \$10 ABT fee). This fee does not apply to the Novice Division.



Main Event

The Open and Intermediate Divisions use a single elimination format with progressive consolation and progressive last chance. The Novice Division format will be determined based on the number of players. See "Entry Fee Structure" section for details on fees and prize pools.

Super Jackpot

Single elimination, 13 point matches, \$1000 entry fee, 95% return. The total number of players must be a power of two; we will waitlist players as necessary.

Badger Classic Masters

Single elimination, 11 point matches, \$400 entry fee, 90% return. Optional \$200 side pool with 100% return. Half-entry qualifier available for \$200.

Zach Tabak Amateur Jackpot

Single elimination, 9 point matches, \$150 entry fee, 90% return. Optional \$100 side pool with 100% return. This event is not open to players who have cashed in an Open or Masters-level event in the last four years.

Doubles
